RULES OF CONDUCT PENALTY GUIDELINES

As a general rule, all participants' conduct is subject to the current FIFA and USSF Laws of the Game, except as expressly modified by the United Soccer League (USL) Rules of Competition and will be judged according to FIFA and USSF standards as modified by the United Soccer League (USL) Rules of Competition and these Rules of Conduct. In the spirit of the game, the following guidelines shall be used when determining suspensions and other penalties. Please refer to the USL Rules of Competition for general information regarding the conduct of individuals. Please note suspensions are not to be counted during forfeits and, or postponements. Below are some of the penalties that will be levied for infractions:

OVER 50 – SENIOR DIVISIONS ONLY:				
15	What would otherwise be a legal, clean tackle in any other division it is not permitted in the Senior Divisions	Indirect free kick		
16	Slide tackle resulting in the awarding of a direct free kick or penalty kick	Yellow or red card at referee's discretion		

Note:

- Players who receive a yellow card in a game are suspended for 10 minutes from the game,
- Players who receive a yellow card in two consecutive games are suspended for 1 game,
- Players who receive 4 yellow cards in a yearly season are suspended for 1 game,
- Players who receive 3 or more red cards in a yearly season must appear before the Board,

All infractions will be reviewed by the Conduct Committee and if necessary, the Competition Committee. It will be the responsibility of the Team Captain and, or Manager of the offending player to contact the Conduct Committee Chairman to discuss any details pertinent to the infraction(s) prior to the next scheduled game. In addition to the discussion with the Team Captain and, or Manager, the referee report will also be used to determine what penalties/suspensions should be assessed based on the infraction(s) committed. If there is no contact made by the Team Captain and, or Manager, then the penalties assessed will be based on the information on the referee's report, using the guideline above. Any questions or clarifications can be directed to the Conduct Committee.
